Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau (Hospital of the Holy Cross and Saint Paul) of Barcelona (Spain), was founded in 1401 when six small medieval hospitals merged. The hospital's former buildings near the center of Barcelona date from the 15th century, and now house the National Library of Catalonia.

The current historical buildings were built between 1901 and 1930, designed by the Catalan modernist architect Lluís Domènech i Montaner. Together with Palau de la Música Catalana, it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It was a fully functioning hospital until June 2009, when a modern healthcare complex was officially opened nearby the former hospital.
